

LEGISLATIVE BILL 11

Approved by the Governor March 07, 2019

Introduced by Blood, 3.

A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to cities and villages; to amend section 18-1720, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to provide for an interlocal agreement with a county to abate, remove, or prevent nuisances as prescribed; and to repeal the original section.
Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 18-1720, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read:

18-1720 (1) All cities and villages in this state are hereby granted power and authority by ordinance to define, regulate, suppress and prevent nuisances, and to declare what shall constitute a nuisance, and to abate and remove the same. Every city and village is authorized to exercise such power and authority within its zoning jurisdiction.

(2) Any city or village may enter into an interlocal agreement pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Act with a county in which the extraterritorial zoning jurisdiction of the city or village is located to provide for joint and cooperative action to abate, remove, or prevent nuisances within such extraterritorial zoning jurisdiction. The governing body of such city or village and the county board of such county shall first approve such interlocal agreement by ordinance or resolution.

Sec. 2. Original section 18-1720, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed.
