Introduced by Murman, 38.

1 1. Strike the original sections and insert the following new
2 sections:

3 Section 1. The State Treasurer shall transfer \$525,000 from the
4 General Fund to the School Emergency Response Mapping Fund on or after
5 the effective date of this act, but before June 30, 2025, on such dates
6 and in such amounts as determined by the budget administrator of the
7 budget division of the Department of Administrative Services.

8 Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$-0- from the School
9 Emergency Response Mapping Fund for FY2023-24 and (2) \$525,000 from the
10 School Emergency Response Mapping Fund for FY2024-25 to the State
11 Department of Education, for Program 158, to aid in carrying out the
12 provisions of Legislative Bill 1329, One Hundred Eighth Legislature,
13 Second Session, 2024.

14 There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2023-24

25 to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 1329, One
26 Hundred Eighth Legislature, Second Session, 2024.

3 hereby reappropriated.

4 The unexpended reappropriation balances of the federal Coronavirus
5 State Fiscal Recovery Fund pursuant to the federal American Rescue Plan
6 Act of 2021, 42 U.S.C. 802, as amended, existing on June 30, 2023, for
7 distribution to a political subdivision that owns or operates a nuclear
8 power plant in Nebraska, less \$137,000, are hereby reappropriated.

9 There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2023-24
10 \$2,500,000 General Funds to enter into a contract with an entity to
11 assist the state, for a period of one year ending no later than June 30,
12 2025, with growing the state's bioeconomy industry as defined by 88 Fed.
13 Reg. 25711 (2023). The entity shall recommend and support strategies that
14 secure federal grants for Nebraska and increase the state's real gross
15 domestic product through bioeconomy development initiatives. The
16 Department of Economic Development shall electronically provide the
17 results of the bioeconomy development initiative to the Legislative
18 Council on or before June 30, 2025.

19 There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2024-25
20 \$5,000,000 General Funds for a state marketing campaign, for the purpose
21 of promoting Nebraska as a place to live, work, and play.

22 There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2023-24
23 \$26,234,402 General Funds, \$84,839,197 Cash Funds, and \$23,737,571
24 Federal Funds estimate for state aid, which shall only be used for such
25 purpose. There is included in the appropriation to this program for

27 and \$20,737,571 Federal Funds estimate for state aid, which shall only be
28 used for such purpose.

29 There is included in the amount shown as aid to this program for

4 shall establish a separate budget subprogram to account for the

8 industry consortiums each fiscal year from regional industries identified
9 by the department to participate in the initiative, which shall be in

11 reach students beginning in the seventh and eighth grades. An annual
12 evaluation report detailing the outcomes of the initiative shall be
13 provided to the Legislature electronically and to the Governor, not later
14 than September 15th each year.
