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**Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

Section 1 would amend § 28-405 to update the list of controlled substances to include metonitazene, eutylone, mesocarb, methiopropamine, and xylazine. This section would also remove fenfluramine.

Section 2 would amend § 28-416 to make a harmonizing change.

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**Explanation of amendments:**

AM2765 would replace the addition of xylazine to list specific chemical designations of xylazine and exclude the administration of xylazine to animals.
