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**Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

LB 933 expands Medicaid coverage for glucose monitors to individuals who meet local coverage determinations and have gestational diabetes.

Sec. 1: Medicaid eligible recipients for glucose monitors shall include all individuals who meet local coverage determinations defined in the federal Social Security Act and shall include individuals with gestational diabetes.

Sec. 2: Repealer

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**Explanation of amendments:**

AM2550 adds a new subsection that provides that it is the intent of the Legislature that no more than \$600,000 in General Funds be appropriated annually for the purpose of implementing these provisions.
