Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This bill proposes changes to the enumerated powers of counties.

Sections 1, 2, and 3 replace the word “compacts” with “agreements” and make a number of revisor changes.

Section 4 modifies the authority of counties to include advocacy for certain individuals domiciled within their boundaries. Such individuals are defined so as to include “any person who is a survivor of domestic violence or sexual assault.” This section also includes numerous revisor changes.

Section 5 contains the repealer.
