**LEGISLATIVE BILL 1198**

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to county records; to amend section 23-3211,
- 2 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to provide for withholding the
- 3 residential address of a county attorney or deputy county attorney
- 4 from the public; and to repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 23-3211, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is  
2 amended to read:

3 23-3211 (1) Unless requested in writing, the county assessor and  
4 register of deeds shall withhold from the public the residential address  
5 of a law enforcement officer, a member of the Nebraska National Guard  
6 acting pursuant to subdivision (3) of section 55-182, ~~or a judge, county~~  
7 attorney, or deputy county attorney who applies to the county assessor in  
8 the county of his or her residence.

9 (2) The application shall be in a form prescribed by the county  
10 assessor and shall include the applicant's name and address and the  
11 parcel identification number for his or her residential address. A law  
12 enforcement officer shall include in the application his or her law  
13 enforcement identification number. A member of the Nebraska National  
14 Guard shall include in the application proof of his or her status as a  
15 member, in a manner prescribed by the county assessor. A judge shall  
16 include in the application the name of the specific court of which he or  
17 she is a judge. A county attorney or deputy county attorney shall include  
18 in the application the county in which he or she acts as a county  
19 attorney or deputy county attorney.

20 (3) The county assessor shall notify the register of deeds regarding  
21 the receipt of a complete application. The county assessor and the  
22 register of deeds shall withhold the address of a law enforcement  
23 officer, member of the Nebraska National Guard, ~~or judge, county~~  
24 attorney, or deputy county attorney who complies with this section for  
25 five years after receipt of a complete application. The officer, member,  
26 ~~or judge, county attorney, or deputy county attorney~~ may renew his or her  
27 application every five years upon submission of an updated application.

28 (4) ~~(2)~~ For purposes of this section, judge includes the judge or  
29 magistrate judge of any court located in this state, including any county  
30 court, any district court, the Court of Appeals, the Nebraska Workers'  
31 Compensation Court, any separate juvenile court, the Supreme Court, and

1 any federal court.
