LEGISLATIVE BILL 1047

Approved by the Governor January 19, 1972

Introduced by William F. Swanson, 27th District

AN ACT to amend section 17-529.02, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, and section 17-601.01, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1971, relating to cities of the second class and villages; to harmonize the provisions thereof with previous legislation; to clarify the meaning thereof; and to repeal the original sections.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 17-529.02, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

17-529.02. Such cities and villages may cooperate with the United States government in protecting against floods and enter into agreements with such government for that purpose. They may, in order to obtain federal funds for that purpose, consent to requirements of the Congress of the United States that such city or village (1) provide without cost to the United States all lands, easements and rights-of-way necessary for the construction of flood control projects, (2) hold and save the United States free and harmless from damages due to the construction works, and (3) maintain and operate all the flood control works after completion in accordance with regulations prescribed by the Secretary of War the Army of the United States.

Sec. 2. That section 17-601.01, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1971, be amended to read as follows:

17-601.01. In any village or Class II school district, the governing body of the village or school district may, by ordinance or resolution, respectively, call a caucus for the purpose of nomination of candidates for offices to be filled in the village or school election. Such caucus shall be held at least ten days before the filing deadline for such election, and the governing body calling the caucus shall publish notice of such caucus in at least one newspaper of general circulation in the county at least once each week for two consecutive weeks before such caucus.

Sec. 3. That original section 17-529.02, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, and section 17-601.01, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1971, are repealed.
