AN ACT to amend section 2-1504.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to the Nebraska Soil and Water Conservation Commission; to abolish an advisory committee and to require the commission to consult with other agencies as prescribed; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 2-1504.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

2-1504.01. There-is--hereby--established--an advisory-committee-to-the The Nebraska Soil and Water Conservation Commission to further coordinate and plan programs and projects which would affect water resources of the State of Nebraska--The-committee--shall--consist of-the-Birector-of-Health-or-his-designated-agent,--the Birector-State-Engineer-or-his-designated-agent,--and-the secretary-of-the--Game--and--Parks--Commission--or--some person-designated-by-the-commission:-The-Nebraska--Soil and--Water--Conservation--Commission--and--the--advisory committee-shall-hold-meetings-to-discuss shall consult regularly with representatives of the Department of Health, the Department of Roads, and the Game and Parks Commission with regard to the programs and projects being planned and under construction.

Sec. 2. That original section 2-1504.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
