

LEGISLATIVE BILL 1440

Approved by the Governor April 8, 1972

Introduced by Thomas C. Kennedy, 21st District

AN ACT to amend sections 28-1301 and 84-306.05, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to state officers; to delete the requirement that expense account statements be sworn; and to repeal the original sections.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 28-1301, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

28-1301. Notwithstanding any other special or general laws relating to certification of claims by any state institution or governmental subdivision of the State of Nebraska, all claims for mileage or other traveling expense provided by law shall be verified--by the oath--or--affirmation--of--the--claimant;--who--shall subscribe--and--acknowledge--his subscribed on a mileage or other traveling expense claim, before an officer--having a--seal. Any person making any false oath--or--affirmation to--any claim for mileage or other traveling expense shall be deemed guilty of perjury and punished accordingly; and it shall be the duty of the court, upon conviction, to render judgment in forfeiture, and such claimant shall be forever barred from collecting such false mileage or other traveling expense claim or any portion thereof.

Sec. 2. That section 84-306.05, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

84-306.05. The Director of Administrative Services is required to have prepared a uniform traveling expense account form to be used by all state officers and employees when rendering traveling expense statements to the director for approval and payment. No traveling expense statement shall be approved for payment unless it is made on the form prescribed and furnished by the director, ~~unless the officer or employee swears that the items listed thereon are true and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief, and that the same were actually spent as necessary traveling expenses in the performance of his duties.~~
