LEGISLATIVE BILL 417

Approved by the Governor April 1, 1971

Introduced by Ellen E. Craft, 45th District

AN ACT relating to historical sites and monuments; to provide for erecting signs or notices restricting the visitation of such historical sites and monuments as prescribed; and to provide a penalty.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. The Nebraska State Historical Society or any other society whose duty it is to preserve historical sites and monuments may restrict visitation at such hours and times as in its judgment would be a detriment to the site or monument. The society responsible for such site or monument may erect appropriate signs or notices restricting any visitation which might subject the site or monument to hazards and defacing. Any person violating the provisions of such signs or notices shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined not to exceed one hundred dollars.
