AN ACT relating to cities of the second class and villages; to amend section 17-107, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1973; to change certain references regarding election of the mayor; to provide for appointment of officers required by ordinance; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 17-107, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1973, be amended to read as follows:

17-107. A mayor shall be elected in the manner provided in Chapter 32, or as provided in this act. 7 and-shall--serve--until--his--successor--is--elected--and qualified: Any vacancy in the office of mayor shall be filled as provided in section 17-115. in-all-cases-of-an election-when when the successful candidate or-condidate receiving-the-highest-number-of-votes for mayor in-such election shall be prevented from assuming office, on account because of disqualification, as-provided--ty--law or otherwise, the incumbent mayor shall not be entitled hold over the term, but such office shall automatically become vacant and an appointment shall be made to fill such vacancy in the manner provided in section 17-115. If the president of the council shall for any cause assume the office of mayor for the unexpired term, there shall be a vacancy on the council which vacancy shall be filled as provided in section 32-4, 152. The mayor, with the consent of the council, may appoint a--city--elerk,--a--eity--engineer,--a--eity treasurer;-a-city-attorney;-and-an-overseer--of--streets who-shall-hold-their-offices-for-one-year--unless--sooner removed-by-the-mayor: such officers as shall be required Ly ordinance or otherwise required by law. Such officers may be removed from office by the mayor. The mayor, by and with the consent of the council, shall appoint such a number of regular policemen as may be necessary, and may also appoint special policemen from time to time exigencies arise. All police officers appointed by time as the mayor and council shall be removable at any time by the mayor.

Sec. 2. That original section 17-107, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1973, is repealed.
