LEGISLATIVE BILL 2

Approved by the Governor January 24, 1973

Introduced by Luedtke, 28

AB ACT to amend section 48-434, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1972, relating to health and safety regulations; to remove the provisions for justice of the peace, police magistrate, or other magistrate; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 48-434, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1972, be amended to read as follows:

48-434. (1) Any person violating any of the provisions of sections 48-425 to 48-432 shall upon conviction thereof be fined not less than fifty dollars nor more than one thousand dollars, or imprisoned for not more than six months, or both.

(2) All prosecutions for offenses relating to health and safety laws and regulations under sections 48-401 to 48-435 shall be brought in the name of the State of Mebraska before any justice-of-the-peace,-police agistrate--or--other--magistrate--or court having jurisdiction thereof. It shall be the duty of all county attorneys in their respective counties to prosecute all persons charged with offenses against the health and safety laws and regulations of this state.

Sec. 2. That original section 48-434, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1972, is repealed.
