## LEGISLATIVE BILL 338

Approved by the Governor May 3, 1973

Introduced by Luedtke, 28

AN ACT to amend sections 23-1112 and 23-1112.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, and section 84-306.03, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1972, relating to mileage allowances; to increase the mileage allowances as prescribed; and to repeal the original sections.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 23-1112, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

23-1112. When it is necessary for any county officer or his deputy or assistants, except any county sheriff or his deputy, to travel on business of the county, he shall be allowed mileage at the rate of not more-than--ten twelve cents per mile for each mile actually and necessarily traveled by the most direct route, if the trip or trips be made by automotile, but if travel by rail or bus shall be economical and practical, he shall be allowed only the actual cost of rail or bus transportation, upon the presentation of his bill for the same accompanied by a proper voucher, to the county board of his county in like manner as is provided for as to all other claims against the county.

Sec. 2. That section 23-1112.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

23-1112.01. If a trip or trips included in an expense claim filed by any county officer or employee for mileage are made by personal automobile or otherwise, only one mileage claim shall be allowed at the rate of ten twelve cents per mile for each mile actually and necessarily traveled by the most direct route, regardless of the fact that one or more persons are transported in the motor vehicle. No charge for mileage shall be allowed when such mileage accrues while using any motor vehicle owned by the State of Nebraska or by a county.

Sec. 3. That section 84-306.03, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1972, be amended to read as follows:

84-306.03. If a trip or trips, included in an expense claim filed under sections 84-306.01 and 84-306.02, are made by personal automobile or otherwise, only one mileage claim shall be allowed at the rate of ten twelve cents per mile for each mile actually and necessarily traveled in each calendar month by the most direct route, regardless of the fact that one or more persons are transported in the same motor vehicle; <u>Provided</u>, funds expended for parking may be claimed in addition to mileage. Such requisition, provided for in section 84-306.02, shall direct the payment of mileage on the basis of the actual cost of travel by rail or bus, where economical or practical and if the mileage expense may be reduced thereby, and shall further direct combined trips with mileage prorated wherever possible. No additional rate of mileage shall be allowed to state inspectors or others who carry state equipment by motor vehicle, regardless of the weight thereof. When such travel is by airplane, authorized as provided in section 84-306.02, there shall be allowed the actual expense incurred.

Sec. 4. That original sections 23-1112 and 23-1112.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, and section 84-306.03, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1972, are repealed.
