AN ACT to amend section 37-905, Reissue Revised Statutes of Netraska, 1943, relating to game and fish; to change the privileges of controlled breeding and shooting areas conferred by license; and to repeal the original section.

Ee it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 37-905, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

37-905. The licensee of any licensed game breeding and controlled shooting area may take, or authorize to be taken, within the season hereinafter fixed and designated and in such numbers as herein provided:

- (1) Hand-reared exotic game birds, including pheasants, botwhite quail, cotyrnix quail, chukar partridge, Hungarian partridge, Hallard ducks and wild turkey, released on licensed areas may-te-taken during the shooting season as provided in sections 37-901 to 37-914; r-but-not-to-exceed-seventy-per-cent-of-the-total number-of-the-species-of-said-game-birds-released;
- (2) Hand-reared Mallard ducks may-be-released-for shooting-purposes-and-one-hundred-per-cent-may-be harvested-by-shooting--hil-birds-so-released that are released for shooting purposes shall be at least twelve weeks of age before liberation date and possess full plumage; and
- (3) All ducks-and-pheasants game tirds released for hunting on a controlled hunting area must be banded prior to release. The licensee shall pay to the Game and Parks Commission the sum of ten cents for each such hand.
- Sec. 2. That original section 37-905, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
