

LEGISLATIVE BILL 982

Approved by the Governor April 15, 1974

AN ACT relating to colleges and universities; to provide for a tuition credit for all members of the Nebraska National Guard upon enrollment in any state university, college, or vocational or technical training school in the State of Nebraska.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Any member of the Nebraska National Guard who shall enroll, on or after the effective date of this act, in any state-supported university, college, or vocational or technical training school shall be entitled to a credit of fifty per cent of the tuition charges of such school. Such entitlement shall be continuous so long as the member of the Nebraska National Guard maintains satisfactory performance with the guard and pursues his course of study in such institution in a manner which satisfies the normal requirements of the institution.

Sec. 2. It shall be the responsibility of the individual member of the Nebraska National Guard to obtain a certificate from his commanding officer attesting as to his satisfactory guard performance and to present the same to the educational institution in order to obtain tuition credit. Such certification shall be accomplished at the time of enrollment for each semester or academic term for which tuition credit is requested.
