## LEGISLATIVE BILL 99

Approved by the Governor February 2, 1973

Introduced by Hasebroock, 18

AN ACT to amend section 35-101, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1972, relating to volunteer firemen; to remove the exemption of volunteer members in any fire company or hook and ladder company from serving upon grand and petit juries in this state; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 35-101, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1972, be amended to read as follows:

All volunteer members in good standing 35-101. in any fire company or hook and ladder company in this state shall be exempt from (4)-serving-upon-all-grand-and petit-juries-in-every-county-in-this-state--within--which the-exempt-member-is-a-resident; and-(2) militia duty in time of peace; Provided, that said certificate of exemption shall be approved and authorized by the council or board of trustees under the seal of the city or village in which the fire department issuing the same When any member shall have retired from such company after having served ten years or more he shall be furnished a certificate of exemption. He--may--claim exemption-from-serving-upon-all-grand-and--petit--juries; Provided, that any Any member in good standing in any fire company or hook and ladder company in this state September 20, 1957, shall be furnished a certificate exemption after five years of service; and--provided further, Provided, when a member serves in different fire companies or hook and ladder companies in this state, or at different times in the same company, he may add the years he previously served to his present membership in order to qualify for such exemption. Persons who received certificates of exemption for five years service prior to September 20, 1957, shall be entitled to a11 exemptions theretofore enjoyed by holders of such certificates.

Sec. 2. That original section 35-101, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1972, is repealed.
