

## LEGISLATIVE BILL 118

Approved by the Governor April 21, 1975

Introduced by Koch, 12

AN ACT to amend section 16-401, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to cities of the first class; to change provisions as to what shall constitute a quorum on the council; to provide the required vote for the transaction of business; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 16-401, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

16-401. Regular meetings of the council shall be held at such times as may be fixed by ordinance, and special meetings whenever called by the mayor or any four councilmen. ~~Two-thirds~~ A majority of all the members elected to the council shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of any business, except as otherwise required by law, but a less number may adjourn, from time to time, and compel the attendance of absent members. An affirmative vote of not less than one half of the elected members shall be required for the transaction of any business.

Sec. 2. That original section 16-401, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
