AN ACT to amend section 49-617, Revised Statutes
Supplement, 1976, relating to distribution of
statutes; to change distribution as
prescribed; and to repeal the original
section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 49-617, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1976, be amended to read as follows:

49-617. The Revisor of Statutes shall cause the statutes to be printed. The printer shall deliver These copies completed copies to the State Librarian. shall be held and disposed of by such librarian follows: Sixty copies to the Nebraska State Library exchange for statutes of other states; five copies to the Nebraska State Library to keep for daily use; not to exceed twenty-five copies to the Nebraska Legislative Council for bill drafting and related services to the Legislature and executive state officers; not to exceed twenty copies to the Attorney General; twelve copies to the Tax Commissioner; eight copies to the Nebraska Publications Clearinghouse; six copies to the Public Service Commission; four copies to the Secretary of State; four copies to the Clerk of the Nebraska Legislature for use in his office and two copies to maintained in the legislative chamber under control of the sergeant at arms: two copies each to the Governor the state, the Chief Justice and each Judge of Supreme Court, the Clerk of the Supreme Court, of Reporter of the Supreme Court, the Court Administrator, the Auditor of Public Accounts, the Commissioner of Labor, and the Revisor of Statutes; one copy each to the Secretary of State of the United States, the library of the Supreme Court of the United States, the Adjutant General, the Air National Guard, the Commissioner of Education, the State Treasurer, the Board of Educational Lands and Funds, the Director of Agriculture, the Director of Administrative Services, the Director of Aeronautics, the Department of Economic Development, the Director of the Public Employees Retirement Board, Director of Health, the Director-State Engineer. the Director of Health, the Director-State Engineer, Director of Banking and Finance, the Director the Insurance, the Director of Motor Vehicles, the Director

of Veterans' Affairs, the Director of Water Resources, the Director of Public Welfare, the Director of Public Institutions, the Director of Correctional Services, the Nebraska Emergency Operating Center, each judge of the Nebraska Workmen's Compensation Court, each judge of the Court of Industrial Relations, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, the Nebraska Natural Resources Commission, the State Real Estate Commission, the secretary of the Game and Parks Commission, the Board of State Real Estate Commission, Pardons, each state institution under the Department of Public Institutions, each state institution under the State Department of Education, the--State-Sheriff, the State Surveyor, the Nebraska State Patrol, Purchasing Agent, State Personnel Office, Nebraska Motor Vehicle Industry Licensing Board, Board of Trustees of the Nebraska State Colleges, each of the Nebraska State Colleges, each district judge of the State of Nebraska, each district county judge, each judge of a separate juvenile court, the Lieutenant Governor, each United each United Nebraska, States States Senator from Representative from Nebraska, each clerk of the district court for the use of the district court, the clerk of the Nebraska Workmen's Compensation Court, each associate county judge, each county attorney, each county public defender, and each county law library of the State of Nebraska, each judge of the municipal court, and the inmate library at all state penal and correctional institutions, and each member of the Legislature shall be entitled to three two complete sets, and three two complete sets of such volumes as are necessary to update previously issued volumes, but each member of the Legislature shall be entitled, on request, to a third complete set: Provided, copies of the statutes distributed without charge, as above listed, shall be the property of the state or governmental subdivision of the state and not the personal property of the particular person receiving a copy. Distribution of statutes to the library of the College of Law of the University of Nebraska shall be as provided in sections 85-176 85-177.

Sec. 2. That original section 49-617, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1976, is repealed.
