

## LEGISLATIVE BILL 176

Approved by the Governor April 1, 1977

Introduced by Reutzel, 15

AN ACT to amend section 53-146, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to liquors; to eliminate the requirement that certain premises be open to view; and to repeal the original section, and also section 53-167, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 53-146, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

53-146. {4} It shall be the duty of the commission and local governing bodies to cause frequent inspection to be made on the premises of on sale beer licensees and if it is found that any such licensee is violating any provision of this act or the regulations of the commission promulgated hereunder or is failing to observe in good faith the purposes of this act, such the license may be revoked after the licensee is given an opportunity to be heard in his defense.

~~{2} No on sale beer licensees shall sell any beer for consumption on any premises having or maintaining any blinds or screens obscuring vision into the premises.~~

Sec. 2. That original section 53-146, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, and also section 53-167, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, are repealed.
