

LEGISLATIVE BILL 749

Approved by the Governor March 3, 1978

Introduced by Chambers, 11

AN ACT relating to civil procedure; to require a report of all criminal homicide cases as prescribed; to provide duties; and to declare an emergency.
Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Each county attorney shall file a report with the State Court Administrator for each criminal homicide case filed by him. The report shall include (1) the initial charge filed, (2) any reduction in the initial charge and whether such reduction was the result of a plea bargain or some other reason, (3) dismissals prior to trial, (4) outcome of the trial including not guilty, guilty as charged, guilty of a lesser included offense, or dismissal, (5) the sentence imposed, (6) whether an appeal was taken, and (7) such other information as may be required by the State Court Administrator. Such report shall be filed not later than thirty days after ultimate disposition of the case by the court.

Sec. 2. The State Court Administrator shall provide all forms necessary to carry out this act.

Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act shall be in full force and take effect, from and after its passage and approval, according to law.
