

LEGISLATIVE BILL 845

Approved by the Governor April 17, 1978

Introduced by Warner, 25

AN ACT relating to the Public Service Commission; to authorize the review of operating conditions of motor carriers permitted to transport people or property under commission approved tariffs; to allow the employment of necessary technical assistance; to prepare and file applications necessary to change effected tariffs; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Any two or more motor carriers authorized to operate under a common tariff approved by the Public Service Commission under the provisions of Chapter 75, article 1 or 3, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, and amendments thereto, shall be permitted to meet and review operational conditions of affected motor carriers for the following purposes: (1) To study the ratio of expenses to income and general financial condition of the motor carrier industry in Nebraska; (2) to determine if any change or changes should be made in any commission approved tariff or tariffs; (3) to consider the joint employment of technical assistance to accomplish the purposes set forth in this section; (4) to determine if it is necessary to file an application to make tariff changes; and (5) to do all other acts necessary to accomplish the filing of a rate application with the commission.

Sec. 2. Since an emergency exists, this act shall be in full force and take effect, from and after its passage and approval, according to law.
