## LEGISLATIVE BILL 271

Approved by the Governor April 20, 1979

Introduced by Hefner, 19

AN ACT to amend section 80-305, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to the Nebraska Veterans' Home; to change membership on the Board of Inquiry and Review as prescribed; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 80-305, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

80-305. For the purpose of determining continued eligibility of members to remain in the home, and for the purpose of recommending matters of policy, rules and regulations, administration, and maintenance pertaining to the home, there is hereby established a special Board Inquiry and Review composed of the Department the each of veterans' Commander of recognized defined by section organizations in Nebraska as 80-401.01, the--Nebraska--Department--Commander--of--the #mited-Spanish-War-Yeterans, the Director Department of Veterans' Affairs of Nebraska, of the immediate past Department Commander of recognized veterans' organizations in each of Nebraska, defined by section 80-401.01. 7-and-the--immediate--past Department-Commander-of-the-United-Spanish--War--Weterans in--Nebraska; -- Provided, -- that -- if -- the -- immediate --- past Department--Commander---of---any---of---these---veterans+ organizations-is-unavailable-to-serve-for-any-reason, then-the-incumbent -- Department -- Commander -- of -- such organization-shall-have-the-power-to-appoint--some--other member-of-his-organization--to--serve--on--the--Board--of Inquiry-and-Review--for--the--same--period--of--time--the immediate-past-Department-Commander-would-serve, -- or - of representatives -- of -- such -- veterans -- - organizations -- or Department -- of -- Veterans -- Affairs -- designated -- by --- the Department-Commander-or-director-thereof: If a commander or immediate past commander of any of such veterans' organizations is unavailable to attend a Board of Inquiry and Review meeting, or unable to serve for any reason, the incumbent department commander of organization may appoint some other member of his or her organization to serve on the Board of Inquiry and Review in the absence of the commander or the immediate past commander, or both. Any of the veterans' organizations mentioned in this section may appoint two representatives of their organization to serve on the Board of Inquiry and Review in place of the department commander and immediate past department commander. Such representatives shall be selected in the manner and serve for such term as the veterans' organization may prescribe. No salary shall be paid to any member of such special board, but actual expenses of the members of the Board of Inquiry and Review when attending regularly called meetings of that board shall be paid from the administrative funds of the Department of Veterans' Affairs.

Sec. 2. That original section 80-305, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
