

LEGISLATIVE BILL 206

Passed over the Governor's Veto March 16, 1981

Introduced by Chambers, 11

AN ACT relating to the Legislature; to provide intent;
and to provide for certain expenses.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. The Legislature hereby finds and declares (1) that the Constitution of Nebraska, by expressly providing for the Legislative branch of government, implies the powers and the duty to provide the means, accessories, and instrumentalities to carry into effect the purposes for which the Legislature was created, (2) that items in the nature of expenses incidental to holding the office are not pay or perquisites within the meaning of Article III, section 7 of the Constitution of Nebraska, and (3) that the Constitution is construed to allow expenses to members of the Legislature, incidental to the performance of their duties as members of the Legislature, without contravening any constitutional provision as to pay, perquisites, or compensation.

Sec. 2. Each member of the Legislature shall be allowed necessary expenses incurred while performing in the official capacity as a member of the Legislature.
