LEGISLATIVE BILL 99

AN ACT to amend sections 26-112, 33-123, and 33-124, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to courts; to change fees as prescribed; and to repeal the original sections...

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 26-112, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

26-112. The clerk of the municipal court shall charge and receive the following fees:

- (1) In civil matters: For any and all services rendered up to and including the judgment or dismissal of the action, ten <u>fourteen</u> dollars; for all orders after judgment, including, but not limited to, writs of execution, restitution, garnishment, examination in aid of execution, taking and approving any recognizance or bond, and furnishing transcripts, one--dollar three dollars each; and
- (2) In criminal matters: For any and all services rendered up to and including the judgment dismissal of the action, and the issuance of mittimus OF discharge to the jailer, six ten dollars; except that all cases handled by a violations bureau established in by the local governing body by ordinance, under the jurisdiction of the municipal court, the court cost shall be as set forth in such ordinance; and for all orders and all services rendered after judgment, including, but limited to, entries and official acts recorded, furnishing transcripts, and taking and approving recognizance or bond, one-dollar three dollars each.

Sec. 2. That section 33-123, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

33-123. The county court shall be entitled to the following fees in civil matters: For any and all services rendered up to and including the judgment or dismissal of the action, ten fourteen dollars; for all orders, after judgment, including writs of execution, restitution, garnishment, examination in aid of

execution, and taking and approving any recognizance or bond, one-dollar three dollars each.

Sec. 3. That section 33-124, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

33-124. In criminal matters including preliminary and juvenile hearings, the county judge shall receive the following fees: For any and all services rendered up to and including the judgment or dismissal of the action and the issuance of mittimus or discharge to the jailer, the sum of six ten dollars; for all orders after judgment and taking and approving any recognizance or bond, one-dollar three dollars each.

Sec. 4. That original sections 26-112, 33-123, and 33-124, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, are repealed.
