

## LEGISLATIVE BILL 268

AN ACT to amend section 24-730, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to retired judges; to change provisions relating to compensation for temporary duty; to repeal the original section; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 24-730, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

24-730. A retired judge holding court pursuant to sections 24-729 to 24-733 shall receive, in addition to his or her retirement benefits, for each day of temporary duty an amount equal to established by the Supreme Court. Such amount, when taken together with one-twentieth of the judge's monthly retirement benefit, shall not exceed one-twentieth of the monthly salary he or she would receive if he or she were an active judge of that court.

Sec. 2. That original section 24-730, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.

Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act shall be in full force and take effect, from and after its passage and approval, according to law.
