AN ACT to amend section 60-412, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to motor vehicle operator's licenses; to provide criteria for inspection of a person's driving record; change a fee; to repeal the original section; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

section 60-412, Reissue Section 1. That Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

60-412. The director shall assign a distinguishing number to each license issued and shall keep an index a record of the same which shall be open to public inspection. Any person requesting such driver record information shall furnish to the department the name of the person whose record is being requested and, when the name alone is insufficient to identify the correct record, the department may request additional identifying information. The department shall, upon request of any applicant, furnish a certified abstract of the operating record of any person and shall be entitled to charge such applicant a fee of one dollar seventy-five cents per abstract. One hundred per cent of the fee on abstracts shall be deposited in the Department of Motor Vehicles Computerization Fund, which is hereby created. Such fund shall be used to develop and operate a system of utilizing a computer to store and print any records and information as deemed necessary by the director.

The director shall also keep a record of all applications for licenses that are disapproved with a brief statement of the reason for disapproval of the application. The motor vehicle operator's license shall be in the form of a card of a size that may be conveniently carried on the person. Each license card shall carry the following statements: Name; age; place of residence; post-office post office address; a brief personal description of the licensee sufficient for identification; and such other facts and information,

not inconsistent with this act, as the director $\boldsymbol{m}_{\boldsymbol{a}\boldsymbol{y}}$ determine.

Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act shall be in full force and take effect, from and after its passage and approval, according to law.
