

## LEGISLATIVE BILL 991

Approved by the Governor April 16, 1986

Introduced by Beutler, 28

AN ACT relating to state statute books; to amend section 49-707, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to provide for sale or disposal of superseded books; to eliminate a duty of the Secretary of State regarding such books; to repeal the original section, and also sections 49-510 and 49-511, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 49-707, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

49-707. The Revisor of Statutes shall cause the supplements and reissued volumes to be copyrighted under the copyright laws of the United States for the benefit of the people of Nebraska:

The supplements and reissued or replacement volumes shall be sold and distributed by the State Librarian at such price as shall be prescribed by the Executive Board of the Legislative Council, which price shall be sufficient to recover all costs of publication.

The State Librarian may sell for one dollar per volume any compilation or revision of the statutes of Nebraska that has been superseded by a later official revision, compilation, or replacement volume. The Supreme Court may authorize the State Librarian to dispose of any unsold superseded volumes in any manner it deems proper.

All The money received by the State Librarian ~~therefor~~ shall be paid into the state treasury to the credit of the General Fund. The State Librarian shall take receipts for all such money paid into the state treasury.

Supplements and reissued volumes shall be furnished and delivered free of charge in the same number and to the same parties as are designated in section 49-617.

Sec. 2. That original section 49-707, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, and also sections 49-510 and 49-511, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, are repealed.
