## LEGISLATIVE BILL 300

Approved by the Governor April 17, 1987

Introduced by Peterson, 21

AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; to amend section 60-412, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, and section 60-403, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1986; to provide for the furnishing and use of certain information as prescribed; to change and provide powers and duties; and to repeal the original sections.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 60-403, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1986, be amended to read as follows:

Except as herein otherwise provided, 60-403. no resident of the State of Nebraska shall operate a motor vehicle upon the streets, alleys, or public highways of the State of Nebraska until the person has obtained a license for that purpose. Application for such an operator's license shall be made under oath or affirmation on uniform blanks prepared and furnished to the county treasurers, examiners of the Department of Motor Vehicles, and any local examiners by the Bireeter of Motor Vehicles director. The standard application blanks shall be sufficient in form and content to substantially carry out the purposes of this act. They shall contain, in addition to any other information and questions necessary to comply with the requirements and purposes of this act, the name, age, post office address, place of residence, date of birth, sex, social security number, except that such social security number shall not be printed on the operator's license and shall be used only to furnish driver record information to the United States Selective Service System under section 60-412 or with the permission of the director in connection with the verification of the status of an individual's driving record in this state or any other state, and a brief description of the applicant and the following specific questions: (1) Do you suffer from any physical defects that would detract from normal ability to safely operate a motor vehicle? (2) Have you suffered dismemberment of foot, leg, hand, or arm? (3) Are you subject to vertigo or fainting spells? (4) Has your operator's license ever been revoked or suspended LB 300 LB 300

in Nebraska or in any other state or jurisdiction in the United States and, if so, give date and period of and reason for each such occurrence.

Sec. 2. That section 60-412, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

60-412. The director shall assign distinguishing number to each license issued and shall keep a record of the same which shall be open to public Any person requesting such driver record inspection. information shall furnish to the department the name of the person whose record is being requested and, when the name alone is insufficient to identify the correct record, the department may request identifying information. The department shall, upon request of any applicant, furnish a certified abstract of the operating record of any person and shall be entitled to charge such applicant a fee of one dollar per abstract. One hundred per cent of the fee on abstracts shall be deposited in the Department of Motor Vehicles Computerization and Operations Fund, which is hereby created. Such fund shall be used to carry out the duties of the department as deemed necessary by the Any money in the fund available director. for investment shall be invested by the state investment officer pursuant to sections 72-1237 to 72-1269.

The director shall, upon receiving a request and an agreement from the United States Selective Service System to comply with requirements of this section and the rules and regulations adopted and promulgated to carry out this section, furnish driver record information to the United States Selective Service System to include the name, post office address, date of birth, sex, and social security number of licensees. The United States Selective Service System shall pay all costs incurred by the department in providing such information but shall not be required to pay any other fee required by law for such information. No driver record information shall be furnished regarding any female, nor regarding any male other than those between the ages of seventeen years and twenty-six years. Such information shall only be used in the fulfillment of the required duties of the United States Selective Service System and shall not be furnished to any other person. The director may adopt and promulgate rules and regulations concerning the preparation, transmittal, safequarding, and disposition of such information.

The director shall also keep a record of all

applications for licenses that are disapproved with a brief statement of the reason for disapproval of the application. The motor vehicle operator's license shall be in the form of a card of a size that may be conveniently carried on the person. Each license card shall carry the following statements: Name; age; place of residence; post office address; a brief personal description of the licensee sufficient for identification; the anatomical gift information specified in section 60-412.01; and such other facts and information, not inconsistent with this act, as the director may determine.

Sec. 3. That original sections 60-412, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, and section 60-403, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1986, are repealed.
