

LEGISLATIVE BILL 674

Approved by the Governor February 10, 1988

Introduced by Chambers, 11; Barrett, 39

AN ACT relating to surrogate parenthood contracts; to declare such contracts void; to provide rights and obligations for biological fathers as prescribed; and to define a term.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. (1) A surrogate parenthood contract entered into shall be void and unenforceable. The biological father of a child born pursuant to such a contract shall have all the rights and obligations imposed by law with respect to such child.

(2) For purposes of this section, unless the context otherwise requires, a surrogate parenthood contract shall mean a contract by which a woman is to be compensated for bearing a child of a man who is not her husband.
