

LEGISLATIVE BILL 969

Approved by the Governor March 21, 1988

Introduced by Peterson, 21

AN ACT relating to rules of the road; to amend section 39-631, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to change provisions prohibiting driving on shoulders of highways; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 39-631, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

39-631. No person shall drive on the shoulders of highways, except that ~~(1) this section shall not prohibit the driving of~~ vehicles may be driven onto the shoulders of roadways (a) by federal mail carriers while delivering the United States mail or (b) to safely remove a vehicle from traffic lanes or and (2) implements of husbandry from being may be driven thereon onto the shoulders of roadways.

Sec. 2. That original section 39-631, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
