

LEGISLATIVE BILL 827

Approved by the Governor February 7, 1990

Introduced by Labeledz, 5, Chairperson, Executive Board

AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; to amend section 60-4,128, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1989; to change a reference to a motorcycle operator's license or permit to harmonize with the classification of licenses made by Laws 1989, LB 285; to provide an operative date; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 60-4,128, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1989, be amended to read as follows:

60-4,128. Whoever violates Any person violating the provisions of section 60-4,127 shall be guilty of a traffic infraction and shall upon conviction thereof be fined not less than ten dollars nor more than one hundred dollars. In addition, a person operating a motorcycle without a ~~motorcycle operator's license or permit~~ Class M license may be required to complete the basic motorcycle safety course as provided in the Motorcycle Safety Education Act.

Sec. 2. This act shall become operative on September 1, 1990.

Sec. 3. That original section 60-4,128, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1989, is repealed.
