

LEGISLATIVE BILL 57

Approved by the Governor June 5, 1991

Introduced by Smith, 33; Wesely, 26

AN ACT relating to public assistance; to provide a personal needs allowance for persons receiving assistance to the aged, blind, and disabled; and to provide an operative date.
Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. The Department of Social Services shall include in the standard of need for eligible aged, blind, and disabled persons at least forty dollars per month for a personal needs allowance if such persons reside in an alternate living arrangement.

For purposes of this section, an alternative living arrangement shall include board and room, a licensed boarding home, a licensed domiciliary facility, a certified adult family home, a licensed residential care facility, a licensed group home for children or child-caring agency, a licensed center for the developmentally disabled, and a long-term care facility.

Sec. 2. This act shall become operative on October 1, 1991.
