

LEGISLATIVE BILL 885

Approved by the Governor February 2, 2000

Introduced by Executive Board: Coordsen, 32, Chairperson

AN ACT relating to the Strategic Air Command Museum; to amend section 81-1211, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to repeal obsolete provisions governing divestment; to harmonize provisions; to repeal the original section; and to outright repeal sections 90-261 to 90-263, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 81-1211, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read:

81-1211. ~~(1)~~ All funds obtained from the sale of tourist promotion items shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the Tourist Promotion Fund which is hereby established. The Department of Economic Development shall make expenditures from such fund to promote and develop the tourist potential of this state. Any money in the fund available for investment shall be invested by the state investment officer pursuant to the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act and the Nebraska State Funds Investment Act.

~~(2) The Director of Economic Development shall allow the curator of the Aerospace Museum in Bellevue, Nebraska, to retain a sum of money not to exceed one thousand dollars to be used as a change cash fund by such curator. The curator shall make an accounting of such money each month to the Director of Economic Development.~~

Sec. 2. Original section 81-1211, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed.

Sec. 3. The following sections are outright repealed: Sections 90-261 to 90-263, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska.
