No Fiscal Impact. LB 1369 would require electric utilities to interconnect self-generation facilities owned or operated by the person controlling an agricultural operation. Although the Power Review Board (the Board) is the agency with primary jurisdiction over electric utilities in Nebraska, the bill does not include any provision authorizing the Board to ensure compliance with the bill's requirements. Since it appears the Board has no direct role in the bill's provisions, there would be no fiscal impact on the Board.
